



A Epistylum. B Frons externa epistylj. C Tignum super epistylj frontem in longum protensum. D Opae.


A B Frons aedis. C D Latus aedis. E Tigna aut in frontem aut in latus obvertenda, ut triglyphi veritatem imitentur.


A Epistylia. B Tigna epistylj intra domum adjacentia.




A Epistylia. B Tigna ab epistylis remota

C Lacunaria quae ab tignis non intercluduntur intra domum.



Aedes Dorica emendationibus Vitruvianis concinnata




A Tigna protensa super media epistylia. B Praecisiones tignorum quae versus extrinsecus apparentium. C Opae extremitates tignorum continentes.












Fig. II. Orthographia frontis ejusdem aedis, ex Le-Royo part. 2. Tab. VII. fig. II.

B Antae frontibus inaequales.




Fig. IV. Sciographia ejusd. pronai.




Fig. III. Sectio pronai ejusd. aedis

B Epistylum Doricum tenuitate a Vitruviano parum differens.








Fig. I. Ichnographia aedis Corinthi, ex Le-Royo p. 2. Tab. III. Fig. I.




Fig. II. Ichnographia aedis Thesei, ex Le-Royo part. 2. Tab. IV. fig. I.




Fig. IV. Orthographia frontis aedis Thesei, ex Le-Royo part. 2. Tab. IV. fig. II.




Fig. III. Contignatio aedis Thesei, ex Le-Royo part. 2. Tab. V. fig. I.




Fig. VI. Sectio aedis Thesei efficta secundum lineam A. C. figurae II. sive lineam M. N. figurae III.












Fig. I. et II. A Intercolumnia clathris obstructa quibus monemur ædes monopteras, loco cellæ qua carebant, fuisse clauas.
