Sir,

I have just written about the Norwegian calcareous algae (*Lithothamnion* + *Lithophyllum*), which paper is mentioned in *Bot. Centralbl.* 1896, No. 16. — I also think to write a monography of the genus, but it is of interest to get specimens from different tracts, so that the list of species may be as complete as possible. I, therefore, take the liberty to ask, whether there in the botanique gardens or University's collections exist european or exotic specimens of these algae and whether you in that case kindly can send me such either for examination + afterwards returned as in exchange for northern *Lithothamnion* or other algae, — or I should like to buy a collection of the named specimens.

I should be happy to receive your answer as soon as possible.
